

PhD Thesis Revision Fellowship (towards monograph/articles)

Eligibility: Candidates should submit documentary proof of recommendation of award of PhD, or original PhD certificate. Thrust area will be Kerala Studies. However, candidates whose work has the potential to significantly contribute to social sciences/humanities may be considered as per the discretion of the selection committee.

Duration: The tenure of the fellowship is one year.

Applications: Applications will be invited once in every academic year. The candidates may submit the applications online as specified. Complete application should include

- 1. Completed application form
- 2. Upload copy of original PhD certificate or a provisional PhD certificate
- 3. One page abstract of thesis (not more than 500 words)
- 4. A proposal of 2000-2500 words that states how the candidate proposes to revise the thesis for publication. (The publication plan need not be restricted to monographs. It can be for articles, book chapters etc.)
- 5. Copy of a valid government certified identity proof
- 6. Copy of reservation certificates issued by the competent authority, if applicable
- 7. List of published academic publications, if any

Evaluation: All proposals will be subjected to a plagiarism check. All incomplete applications, and applications received after the deadline will be rejected. The decisions of the Selection Committee will be final.
