Funding for organizations which are not educational institutions for conducting academic programmes

The financial assistance is for organizations **registered in Kerala**, which are not educational institutions, and who wish to conduct academic programmes related to **Kerala Studies**. The upper limit of the grant is Rs. 50,000/-, and will be given only if the intention of the organization is made evident and is approved by the KCHR.

Amount: A maximum of Rs. 50,000 will be granted as financial assistance which can be used for partial/ full funding of the program.

Eligibility: Registered organizations which are not educational institutions can apply for financial assistance to conduct academic programs.

Application Process: Applications should preferably be sent two months in advance of the program through the application portal.

Proposal Guidelines

- Proposal and budget estimate should be sent in Microsoft Word format.
- All proposals are subjected to plagiarism checks. Proposals that do not adhere to ethical academic standards will be summarily rejected.
- The applicant should remove all identifiers from the document (eg. Name of institution, name of applicant etc.).
- The proposal should contain a detailed concept note (of not less than 2000 words) on the proposed theme, its relevance, the expected outcome of the program), organization of the program (Duration, sessions, session themes, tentative list of speakers, target group etc.)
- A detailed budget estimate should be uploaded separately with subheads specifying the amount expected from the KCHR.

Decision of the KCHR on applications will be final
