

Designed as a dynamic space for **methodological training**, **interdisciplinary exchange**, **and critical reflection**, this three-day residential workshop is intended for PhD scholars working in the fields of history, the social sciences, and allied disciplines, with a specific interest in Kerala. Bringing together historiographical review, source-based inquiry, and thematic exploration, the workshop aims to foster methodological rigor and interdisciplinary approaches in the practice of contemporary historical research.

Key Focus Areas for Paper Presentations

Participants are invited to submit proposals that engage with one or more of the following themes:

I. Historiography and Sources

- Review of Research in Kerala Society and History
- Overview of Sources in Modern History
- Overview of Sources in Pre-Modern History

II. Themes in Contemporary Historical Inquiry

- Economic Change and Political Formation
- Caste and Community
- Bondage and Slavery
- Gender and Sexuality: Feminist and Queer Interventions in History
- Orality, Performance, and Memory as Historical Sources
- The Malayali Overseas: Migration, Diaspora, and Transnational Networks
- Literary Expressions and the Role of Media
- Environment and Climate Change

- PhD Research Proposal (1500-2000 words) must clearly outline the research question, methodological approach, and relevance to one or more workshop themes.
- Submissions are welcomed in English or Malayalam.
- Include a short bio (100 words), institutional affiliation, and contact details.
